Seven Trumpets of Revelation 8:6-11:19	Seven Bowls of Rev 15:1-16:21
Hail and fire mixed with blood → a earth, trees and grass burned up (8:7)	Foul and evil sores (16:2)
Burning mountain falls into the sea (8:8) → a sea life dies → a ships destroyed (8:9)	Sea becomes blood (16:3)
Blazing star fall on a rivers and fountains (8:10) → a waters poisoned → many people die (8:11)	Rivers and fountains become blood (16:4)
a sun, moon, and stars darkened → a day and a night kept from shining (8:12)	Sun allowed to scorch people → People curse God; do not repent (16:8)
Star falls from heaven to earth, opens abyss → locusts emerge (9:1-11)	Kingdom of beast in darkness → People curse God and do not repent
4 angels bound at Euphrates released; → large cavalry kills (9:13-19) → Rest of humanity does not repent of evil (9:20-21)	Euphrates dries up, opening way for kings of east; kings of whole world at Armageddon (16:12-16)
Kingdom of this world becomes the kingdom of Christ (11:15-18)	Earthquake splits Babylon into 3; cities destroyed (16:17-21)

Frogs (v 45b)	Frogs (v 30)	Blight and mildew destroy crops (v 9a)
Caterpillars and locusts (v 46)	Flies and gnats (v 31)	Locusts devour trees Yet people do not return to God (v 9b)
Hail and frost destroy vegetation (v 47)	Hail lightning destroy vines (vv 32-33)	Pestilence (v 10a)
Hail and lightning destroy livestock (v 48)	Locusts destroy crops (vv 34-35)	Conquest in war (v 10bc) Yet people do not return to God
Death of firstborn (vv 49-51)	Destruction of firstborn (v 36)	Some overthrown, Sodom and Gomorrah (v 11) Yet people do not repent
